### Better user experience

**Only relevant authorisation templates are shown.**

Starting with AEOS 2023.1, authorisation templates in the announce screen are now only shown based on the carrier type. So, you'll only see authorisation templates belonging to a certain carrier type.

Now, it's even easier to welcome a visitor and assign them their relevant access authorisations.

### Explore more DESFire functions

**EV2 secure messaging for transparent card readers**

EV2 secure messaging, a function of the Mifare DESFire EV2 and EV3 badges, has now been implemented for transparent card readers, helping you make use of best security practices with AEOS.

### Improved Cybersecurity

**TLS 1.3 support**
