AEOS 2024.1 introduces Nedap Mobile Access which complements AEOS access control solutions by extending access control functionality to mobile devices. Currently, Nedap Mobile Access is available for use with iPhones and Apple Watches allowing users to conveniently and seamlessly enter their workplace locations using a mobile pass in Apple Wallet.

Nedap Mobile Access app

Self-provisioning of mobile passes in the Apple Wallet

- The Nedap Mobile Access app is a free app that can be downloaded in the Apple App Store.
- The app is only needed to create the mobile pass and add it to Apple Wallet. Carriers can then suspend (and resume) their own mobile passes via their iCloud account.
- Alongside the Nedap Mobile Access app, there is an SDK that allows businesses to integrate with their own iOS applications.

Express Mode as default

No need to wake or unlock Apple devices to gain access

- Users can gain access with just a tap of their Apple device to a compatible reader.
- Express Mode is enabled by default for Apple Access transactions but can be overruled at specific entrances.
- Secure areas can be configured to always require Two Factor Authentication (2FA) such as Face ID, Touch ID, or passcode even if users have enabled Express Mode.



And much more

Extra benefits for the user experience

- Enabling carriers for mobile access can be set up via SOAP, where you're also provided status details and mobile enrollment via 3rd party applications like PIAM systems.
- Power Reserve gives Apple device users up to 5 hours of mobile pass use even after the device battery is empty.
- Pass design allows for your organisation's brand to shine.
